Message from the East





Greetings Brethren,

This month I think an appropriate theme would be "unpredictability" given the upside down times we find ourselves in. A great example is found in Jephthah and the Gilead army story from the Book of Judges which is given during the Fellow Craft Degree.

Jephthah is not fictional but a real person that history knows well. He was one of twelve Judges-actually military rulers- who ruled over Israel. Like the other eleven Judges before and after him, he was a very unlikely and *unpredictable* choice for a ruler. Not only was he the son of a prostitute, he was cast out by his own brothers and was famous for his rashness. Few would have *predicted* that he

would succeed in triumphing over adversity. Yet he did. We learn during the degree that under his leadership the men of Gilead defeat the Ephraimites. What is not pointed out is that the Gilead army, that usually numbered many thousands, numbered only a few hundred on the day of their battle with the Ephraimites. They were *predicted* to lose; so therefore their victory would not be attributed to the greatness of Jephthah but could only be attributed to the *unpredictability* of Gods salvation. And now in the words of Paul Harvey, you know the rest of the story.

I was recently given a newly published book, Faith is Not Blind, written by a local minister, Jeffrey Kliemer who makes the point that the story of the book of Judges "...develops a theme about the predictability of sin and the unpredictability of salvation." He continues; "...sinfulness becomes predictable as the Book of Judges unfolds....But from where God's salvation comes is unpredictable."

May the *predicable* chaos that our country now finds itself in, be soon cured by some salvation no matter how *unpredictable*. And may brotherly love prevail...



To download and use the Medford Lodge #178 app, you can visit Play Store or iTunes store to download-just search Medford Lodge #178


Once you download the app at your app store you will be able to:
