My Brother,



History shows us that the term Fellowcraft had a different but similar meaning in Operative Masonry. The term "fellow" meant one belonged to a group, guild or "craft." In this craft there were officers and subordinates, or Apprentices. There was only one Master who led the craft.

Operative Masonry clearly had defined roles and as such created subordinates. One would have to prove himself in his knowledge and proficiency so that he could advance to become a Fellow within the craft.

As Operative Masonry membership began to dwindle it was decided to allow members who were intrigued by the craft for personal or political reasons. This gave rise to Speculative Masonry and eventually led to what we know as Free Masonry today.

In the previous messages I have spoken about laying of the foundational cornerstone then the testing of character and continuously improving on oneself. As we approach the Degree of Fellowcraft we turn our focus from testing man's character to focusing on the

man himself.

During the Passing of the man we focus on how he is an instrument of the Supreme Architect, his dignity and worth as an individual and his duty.

His duty as a man is to invent, create and achieve. This allows him to express his own genius and individuality. It also continues with what we were taught in the Initiation and symbolizes the man always seeking light.

Previous we were taught every man has a friend to guide him through his journey. During this degree we are taught that every man is responsible for himself; to educate himself and achieve. Without the raw ambition of the individual our Fraternity would not exist.

This ambition allows him to seek light, ask for guidance, prove his proficiency, and not only improve himself in Masonry but also in life. While the Fellow Craft degree focuses on self we must remember that we cannot always travel alone; after all we are accepting a Fellow into the Craft.



- View and upload photos from lodge events



Letter from the Worshipful Master

My Brother:

I hope this letter receives you well. I have a goal this year to increase lodge attendance in our regular and emergent communications, decrease costs, and increase revenue for our lodge. Listed below are areas that I, along with the Officers and Committees of the Lodge, have determined where we can save money and increase revenue.

Trestleboards:

In the world we live in we have many ways in which we can communicate. Some ways are new and innovative that try to use the current technology we have and some are the way we always have done it. If we treat our Lodge like a business we cannot keep going with the "status quo", we must be willing to accept change and adjust to stay competitive.

Currently we have at least 5 ways of communicating what is happening in Medford: (1) Medford Lodge Website, (2) Individual Email, (3) Medford App via Smart Phones, (4) Mail via Postal Service, (5) Facebook. Of the 261 Masons in "Good" standing we mail 57 Trestleboards that cost about \$125 every month; we also spend approximately \$45 per month on the Medford App. To try and reduce monthly cost I would like to stop using the Postal Service. Currently of the 57 mailers we send I have 39 Members that do not have an email address listed. If we can stop using the postal service, the Lodge will save at least \$960 annually. If you are willing to use one of the other (4) methods, please email me.

Increasing Revenue & Raise Awareness of Available Resources:

Everyone knows that Masons come from all walks of life. However; what everyone doesn't always know is what expertise we have available to one another. We have: Day-Traders, Mortgage Brokers, Attorney's, Contractors, Manufacturers, Sales, Bankers, Investors, the list goes on and on.

It is sometimes difficult to determine who you can trust when you are looking for a certain service. Often, we rely on word of mouth, check online for reviews, know someone personally who has a prior experience to determine who we can trust with what we are asking the service for.

What I would like to do is assemble a list of Members and what service they provide and include it in every Monthly Trestleboard and on the Medford Lodge Website Resources page. Through doing this we accomplish multiple things: (1) we publish what expertise we have in the Lodge, (2) the Brother gets additional exposure for their business, (3) you have a list of people you can trust when you need something specific done. To be on this list of resources we are asking for an annual Lodge donation of \$100 which will go towards the daily operations, upkeep, and improvements to the Lodge.




My Dear Brothers,


