Message from the East





Dear Brothers.

The point of this message isn't to not only encourage the exploring the various areas of Freemasonry by other means than just attending a meeting, but to bring that light back to the lodge to share your Brothers. By the way, AD or Anno Domini is Latin for "in the year of our lord" and is the numeric year we are all familiar with, while AL or Anno Lucis is Latin for "Year of Light". Many believe that the Bible dates the creation of the world to be 4000 years prior to the birth of Christ, i.e. when the Lord said "let there be light", therefore we add 4000 to the current year to get the number of years since light.

So, go out and explore the different aspects of Freemasonry, it is what I believe separates us from other organizations, and bring these thoughts, ideas, information back to share with your Brothers.




To download and use the Medford Lodge #178 app, you can visit Play Store or iTunes store to download-just search Medford Lodge #178

- View and upload photos from lodge events




