Message from the East



Dear Brothers,

An important principal of Freemasonry and a duty of a Mason is charity. Charity not only towards our brothers, but charity towards all mankind. The notion of charity is mentioned throughout our ceremonies and is one of the first lessons taught when we are initiated as a Mason. We are also taught that our charity extends beyond our own mortal lives. What's the old saying "It is better to give then to receive".

Most men when they apply to become a Mason say their main attraction was the benevolence of our fraternity. This benevolence is reflected though out our fraterni-

ty, by the various charitable works of our blue lodges, Grand Lodges and our appendant bodies.

When a person thinks of charity they usually think in terms of monetary donations, because money, let's face it, is important. My first memories of charity are the Jerry Lewis Labor Day Telethons which raised money for MS. Every time a certain monetary level was reach, right before they announced it they would do a big build up with a drum roll, etc. But as pointed out in a message last year by WB Murray our charity can take many forms beyond monetary.

This leads to a story I would like to relay. There was a young man, a teenager, whose father, a brother mason, past away. The Senior Warden from the lodge, knowing the family, called another Brother from the lodge to see if he could find a part time job for the young man. The Brother reply that the call came at the right time and asked if the young man could meet with him after school for an interview. The next day the teenager showed up and the two immediately connected. The Brother's name was Frank Land, the young man's name was Louis Lower. Eventually Louis would introduce him to his friends and they would form a club named DeMolay. "Dad" Land probably never thought, prior to taking that call and interview, about forming a boy's club nor that he would be one of the principal founders of one of the largest young men's organizations in the world. He was just fulfilling his obligation as a mason.

Registration Procedure for Electronic Balloting Deadline Wednesday, April 4th

Per C&L, Past Masters (PM) may cast their ballots for elected Grand Lodge offices (Title 3, Article IV, Section 2, Part 1) using an Internet connection. This article will outline the process you must follow in order to vote at a location other than the Balloting & Registration Room at the Annual Communication in Atlantic City. You may vote from any device (desktop, tablet, mobile) that has an Internet connection and Web browser.

You MUST REQUEST AN OFF-SITE BALLOT by PRE-REGISTERING.

To pre-register, you must send an e-mail by 11:59 pm Eastern Time, Wednesday, April 4th, 2018 to GLNJVOTING@GMAIL.COM containing:

- Your Full Name
- Your E-mail Address
- Your Member Number (found on your dues card or through your Lodge Secretary)
- NJ Lodge Name/Number

Once your eligibility is verified, you will receive a confirmation e-mail stating that you have successfully registered. Approximately 3 days prior to the start of balloting, you will receive an e-mail with an encrypted link that will, once balloting begins, take you to the appropriate webpage. The e-mail will also contain additional information and instructions. Remember, registration for off-site voting will close at 11:59 pm Eastern Time on Wednesday, April 4th, 2018.

Balloting will be open from approximately 12:00 noon on Wednesday, April 11th until sometime between 9:00 am and 10:00 am Thursday, April 12th (all times Eastern). Once balloting starts, an e-mail will be sent to those who have registered reminding them that the ballot is now open. Off-site balloting may be done at ANY TIME while balloting is open in Atlantic City. Please note that the times for the start and end of off-site voting are variable depending on when the Grand Master starts and stops balloting on-site. Off-site balloting will end at the same time as on-site balloting. Please do not take a chance and wait until the last minute - vote before 9:00 am Thursday!

You may request an off-site ballot if you are a PM of any lodge in a recognized jurisdiction and a member in good standing of a Lodge under the jurisdiction of the Grand Lodge of New Jersey, F&AM. Please note that the WM, SW and JW must cast the vote assigned to their office on-site (per C&L). If the WM, SW or JW is also a PM (previous year) and they are not able to attend the Annual Communication, they may only cast their PM vote off-site and must follow the procedure above to register for that ballot

Dear Brother Secretary,

We will be introducing a new and advanced method to vote on Grand Lodge Legislation this year. Instead of using the red and green cards to manually vote on legislation, each voting member will vote via a hand held LCD response card. This technology is currently used by many of the jurisdictions in North America. This method of voting is easier to use, better documented, and provides a private vote.

The way it works is simple: there is software that controls the timing of the vote, calculations, and delivery. The legislation will be presented on two large video screens in the Annual Communication. As in the past, Counsel will present it and there will still be the opportunity for three in favor and three opposed on the legislation. Once the motion is called, you will have 30 seconds to vote on your hand held response card once the green light appears on the screens, and you can change your vote as many times as you want within that time period. At the completion of 30 seconds a red light will appear on the screens and that will complete the voting. Within 5 seconds after the completion of voting the totals will appear on the screen.

This process will also be capable of any amendments to legislation from the floor. The totals generated from voting are numbers not identifiable to any voter, and can incorporate any off-site electronic voting.

As we get closer to the Annual Communication, additional information will be provided on how the devices will be distributed and turned in.


