# Message from the East



Dear Brothers,

Recently I was searching various masonic podcast on YouTube and ran across videos from The Academy of Masonic Knowledge of the Grand Lodge of Pennsylvania, which led me to their website and eventually, Facebook. Over the last several weeks they have had several posts which I found interesting and thought I would share with you.

1. Masons use the term "Cowan" to refer to someone who isn't a Brother and who attempts to pass himself off as a member. Today, Brothers sometimes use Cowan to label anyone who isn't a Mason. Historically, the term originates in Scotland, and denominates someone who performs the work of a Mason without the credentials. Alternately, it could be used to denote someone who builds walls without mortar, only using the weight of the materials to hold the structure in place. (Source "Mackey's Encyclopedia of Freemasonry")
2. "Cable tow" is a phrase familiar to all Masons, but one that doesn't appear much in daily life outside of the Craft. It is thought that the term originates with the ancient builders. In former times, a piece of yarn or spun fiber was called a "taw" or "tau." If you took several pieces of these fibers and spun them into a thick, corded rope, you'd produce a "cable-taw." Through the evolution of language, it is thought that the phrase morphed into "cable tow," having become a well-known symbol for all Freemasons.
3. Where did the term "Freemason" come from? Some think that it relates to the working status of the man, with "free" implying that he was not enslaved or indentured. But, the earliest references to the term imply a different angle. Usually found in Latin or French, we find terms such as "sculptores lapidum liberorum" (London 1212), "magister lathomus liberarum petrarum" (Oxford 1391), and "mestre mason de franche peer" (Statute of Labourers 1351). These phrases imply a man worked in "freestone," which is a grainless sandstone or limestone suitable for building construction. In contrast we find terms translated as "Rough Mason" or "Layer", which implied a less skilled worker who had not yet mastered his craft.
4. If you were to describe the layout of a typical Masonic Lodge room, what would you say? Most would call it a rectangle. However, the correct answer is "an oblong square." In early geometry, a "square" was defined as any object composed of right angles. Thus, the two shapes we call a rectangle and a square were one in the same to operative masons. To differentiate the two, the craftsman began to refer to one as a "perfect square" and the other as an "oblong square."

My point in sharing this information above is that there is a vast amount of masonic knowledge available to you in various forms. We live in an age when a vast library is at your finger tip just by opening a website. Therefore, our masonic education shouldn't end when the Worshipful Master closes the lodge but should continue as we strive to make ourselves better men.

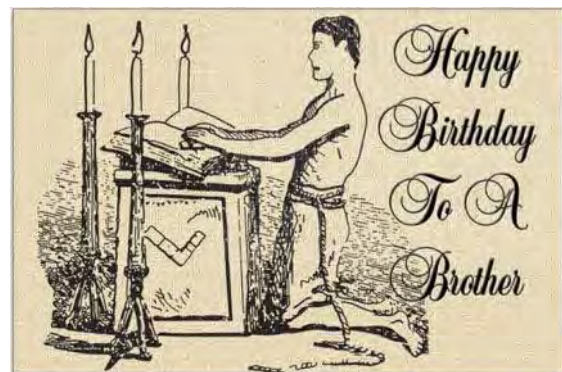

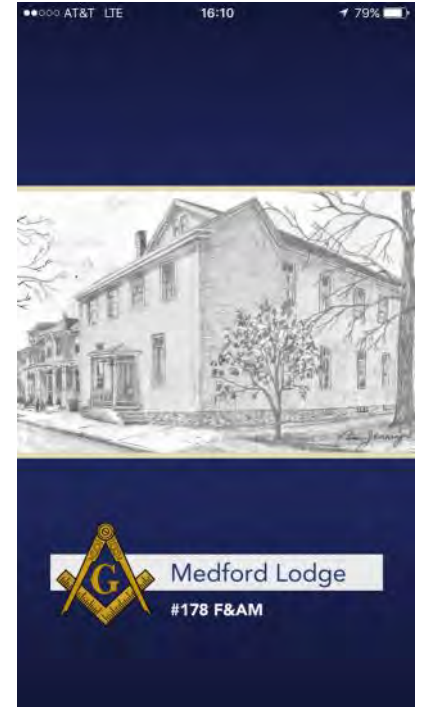

To download and use the Medford Lodge #178 app, you can visit Play Store or iTunes store to download- just search Medford Lodge #178

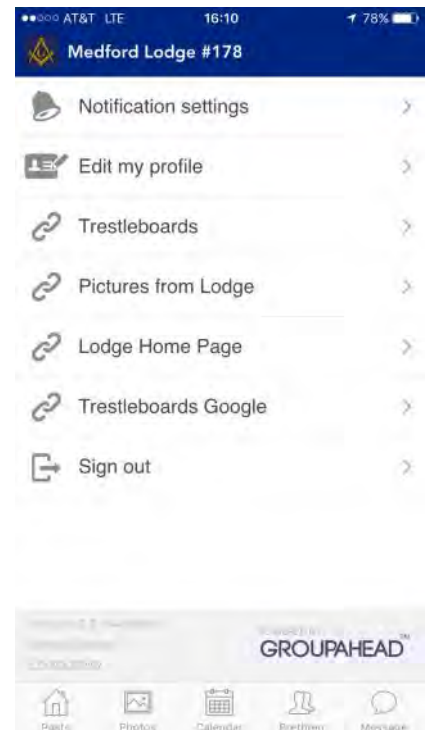
Once you download the app at your app store you will be able to:

Prior to the Annual Grand Communication of The Most Ancient and Honorable Society of Free & Accepted Masons for the State of New Jersey, a new software application, *Circumscribe*, was presented and the implementation began shortly thereafter. The Lodge membership data migration is now complete, and you now have access to the new system. It is important for you to login as soon as possible, review your profile, make any appropriate changes to your contact information, and upload a current picture for your new permanent ID card.

To login to Circumscribe, simply follow these instructions:

Open your internet browser

**NOTE:** *be sure to enable cookies, and disable private browsing*

Navigate to: <https://glnj.circumscribe.net>

Enter your initial Username:

"NJ" + "Your Grand Lodge Number" + "@changeyouremail.info"

(**Example:** *NJ1234567@changeyouremail.info*)

**NOTE:** your Grand Lodge Number is printed on your current Dues card.

Enter your temporary Password:

"NJ" + "Your Grand Lodge" (example: *NJ1234567*)

You will be immediately prompted to change both your username and password

Your NEW username can be any email address that you frequently use, or have regularly access to.

Your NEW password must contain 8 characters and 1 number, and you must enter it twice.

Upon successfully entering both, you will be required to logout, and then log back in with your new credentials.

Once you have successfully logged back in, navigate to your Masonic profile by selecting 'Profile' from the menu items on the left side of the screen. Review your profile and make any appropriate changes to your contact information, and upload a current picture for your new permanent ID card. **You must upload your picture prior to May 31, 2018. After this date, you will be sent a dues card without your picture, and replacement cards are \$5.00 each.** When uploading your picture, use as high a resolution as possible, and your face should be positioned to take up as much of the photo square as possible. You should avoid hats, sunglasses, other individuals or animals in the picture.

Select 'Save Profile' to complete the process.

Report on the 231<sup>st</sup> Annual Communication of Grand Lodge, 89<sup>th</sup> Annual Meeting of the Masonic Charity Foundation of New Jersey, 13<sup>th</sup> Annual Meeting of the Historic Trenton Masonic Temple, Inc., and the 3<sup>rd</sup> Annual Meeting of the Grand Lodge of New Jersey Ashlar Fund, Inc. held in Atlantic City, New Jersey on April 11 and 12, 2018.

#### Officers Elected
