Greetings Brethren,

This month Medford Lodge is fortunate to have two candidates passing to the Fellow Craft Degree. One of the most popular sections on that degree seems to be the middle chamber lecture. Consisting of three, five and seven steps. While a staircase needs every step to function, my favorite steps are the five senses. As Carl H. Claudy writes in “Introduction to Freemasonry II Fellow craft”, without the five senses, a man has “...no contact whatever with the material world he can learn nothing of it.” But as Claudy also points out, perception without the curiosity and intelligence of the mind will not lead mankind to the desire and ability to “..imitate the Divine plan, and to study symmetry and order.” Which then led to the development of the seven liberal arts

and sciences.

Newton made a simple observation of gravity, which led to physics then the need for calculus which aided quantum mechanics which gave Einstein the tools to develop his theories of relativity which led back to gravity. All because a long time ago Newton approached an observation given to him by sight with “industry and zeal” to study that which has always been in plain view.

All that from just one step of the winding stairway. No wonder the middle chamber lecture is so interesting and popular.

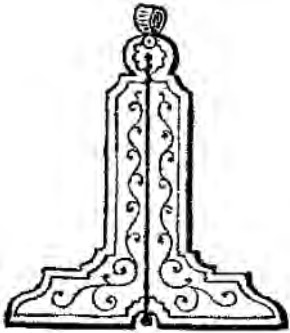

It is an honor serving as the Senior Warden of Medford Lodge for the current Masonic year. One of the duties of the Senior Warden is to read passages from the Book of Constitutions. The Book of Constitutions highlights masonry's high "regard for and obedience to law."

There is another important "Book of the Law" in lodges called the Holy Bible. The Holy Bible is a reminder that "light should be diffused among the brethren." The Encyclopedia of Freemasonry points out that opened passages displayed can vary with "different degrees." Medford Lodge may want to consider reviving this custom for the future degrees.

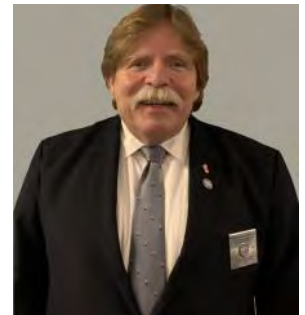

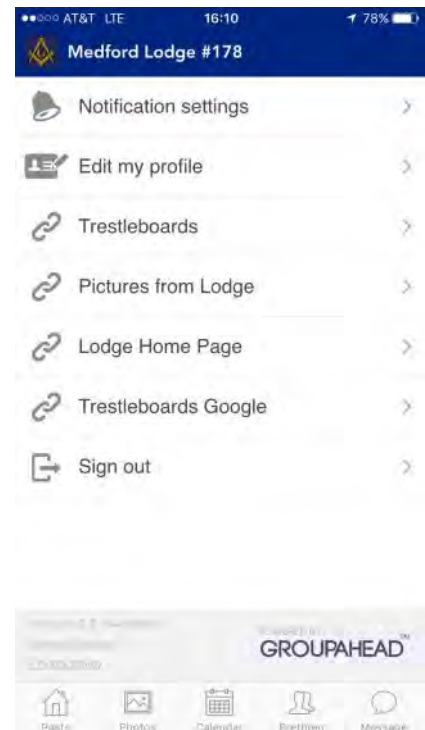
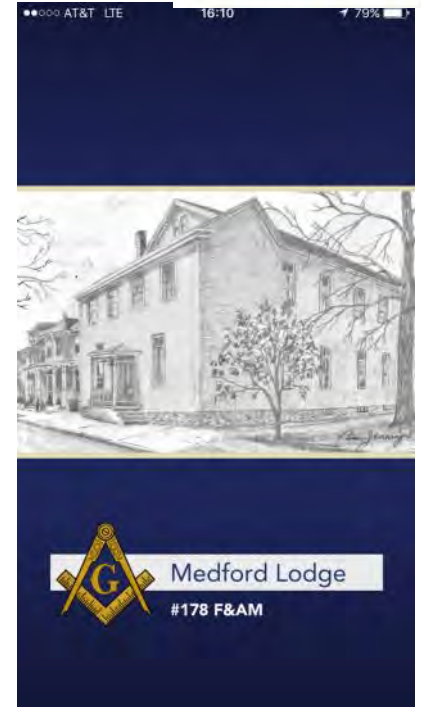

Article for 2020 NJ Freemason – Spring Issue

Registration Procedure for Electronic Balloting Deadline Tuesday, April 7th

Per C&L, Past Masters (PM) may cast their ballots for elected Grand Lodge offices (Title 3, Article IV, Section 2, Part 1) using an Internet connection. This article will outline the process you must follow in order to vote at a location **other than** the Balloting & Registration Room at the Annual Communication in Atlantic City. You may vote from any device (desktop, tablet, mobile) that has an Internet connection and Web browser.

You MUST REQUEST AN OFF-SITE BALLOT by PRE-REGISTERING.

To pre-register, you must send an email by **11:59pm Eastern Time, Tuesday, April 7th, 2020** to GLNJVOTING@GMAIL.COM containing:

- Your full name
- Your email address
- Your Member Number (found on your dues card or through your Lodge Secretary)
- NJ Lodge Name/Number

Once your eligibility is verified by the GL office (which may take a few days), you will receive a confirmation email stating that you have successfully registered. Then, on the morning of Wednesday, April 22nd, you will receive an email with an encrypted link that will take you to the appropriate webpage to vote. This email will also contain additional information and instructions. Remember, **registration for off-site voting will close at 11:59pm Eastern Time on Tuesday, April 7th, 2020.**

Balloting will begin at approximately 12:00 noon on Wednesday, April 22nd until sometime between 9:00am and 10:00am Thursday, April 23rd (all times Eastern). Once balloting starts, an email will be sent to those who have registered reminding them that the ballot is now open. Offsite balloting may be done at ANY TIME while balloting is open in Atlantic City. Please note that the times for the start and end of off-site voting are variable depending on when the Grand Master starts and stops balloting on-site. Off-site balloting will end at the same time as on-site balloting. **Please do not take a chance and wait until the last minute – vote any time before 9:00am Thursday!**

You may request an off-site ballot if you are a PM of any lodge in a recognized jurisdiction **and** a member in good standing of a Lodge under the jurisdiction of the Grand Lodge of New Jersey, F&AM. Please note that the WM, SW and JW must cast the vote assigned to their office on-site (per C&L). If the WM, SW or JW is also a PM (previous year) and they are not able to attend the Annual Communication, they may only cast their PM vote off-site and must follow the procedure above to register for that ballot.
