

Greetings Brethren,

In the May 2022 Trestle Board, I addressed some possible responses to the question, "What is a Mason?" By coincidence, I found responses to similar and related questions made by the famous composer, Franz Liszt. In 1841, Liszt was a candidate for initiation at a Masonic Lodge in Germany. As part of his examination, Liszt was asked to answer three main questions, which I believe you may find interesting and revealing about Freemasonry then and now.


Liszt was first asked to answer the question: What is the Purpose of Man in Life?

He provided the following response: "The purpose of Man is to aim at any possible perfection in Truth, Virtue, and Beauty, thereby – as far as his limitations permit – seeking a union with his creator."

Franz Liszt was then asked: What do you expect from Freemasonry for your soul, your heart, and your material happiness?

He responded: "I believe and hope to enter into a union of good and just men, uniting in the preparation of these aims. I believe that my mind will find nourishment, and fraternal hands will give support in dangers and difficulties."

Finally, Liszt was asked: What can Freemasonry expect from you."




